


In 2019, UIPHP implemented 15 projects:

- 98 healthcare workers were engaged to systematic online trainings of the IMPACT project (ECHO) in 2019.

Strategy, management, and finances



- A field session of strategic planning of the Institute's activities and 4
 working meetings were held. A draft strategic plan for 2020-2024 has
 been prepared.
- The process of reorganization of the financial and administrative department has started
- A visit to Boston University and Brown University to present UIPHP research for further cooperation was made.
- 13 staff members received advanced training at 17 training sessions and workshops;
- 2 employees are doing the Ph.D. program;
- 2 employees are trained in the master's program;
- 26 applications were received by the IRB, 3 of them were paid with the amount of 18500 UAH; payment for one application is expected in 2019;
- 12 (planned 10) project applications were prepared, 3 of which were supported, 5 were rejected, and 4 are under consideration.








Financing dynamics of the UIPHP project activity in 2012-2019, USD




Organization budget revenue structure in 2019 (by donors)
